Admission Procedure:

Admission to First Year B. Pharmacy through Centralized Admission Process (CAP) by competent authority. The candidates allotted through CAP round, should report to the college during office hours. The candidate shall report to the college with all original documents needed to substantiate the claims made in the application regarding eligibility and reservation. The student should get application form along with information brochure and submit the form in the office after filling it duly. After the scrutiny of original documents, the candidate will have to pay prescribed fees immediately in the form as prescribed by the college and confirm the admission

offered. The candidates are required to pay the fees in the form of Demand Draft in favour of the **Lokmanya Tilak Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences**, payable at Pune. Rules and Regulation:

- The students have to maintain 80% attendance in each theory & practical separately. If they failed to do so they will not be allowed to appear for sessional examinations.

- The student should not remain absent in the college without prior permission from Principal, failing to do so the student must bring parents consent letter.
- The attendance for the sessional exam of theory & practical's conducted by the college is compulsory.
